# STAR GAZING IN THE MALDIVES

o you know what constellations are in the sky above you? Can you tell what each ball of light is? As you zoom in on the stars twinkling in the dark through a telescope, an expert in astronomy tells you the names of the distant spheres. You might even pick out Mars or Venus.

At Soneva, seeing the jewels in the sky is one of the special experiences on offer. Soneva Jani boasts the first over-water observatory in the Maldives.

Here you can dine on the deck in the middle of the Indian Ocean, on tables fitted with screens linked to the telescope, so you view the changing skies as you eat. At Soneva Fushi, the sister resort based a short boat ride away, the observatory is built high above the rainforest, giving you a panoramic view of the island.


