Tom Petty

Petty went by the name "Tommy Petty" until he started releasing albums then he changed his name to "Tom Petty" for it to look better in print. But his friends who knew him from before fame still call him "Tommy". American rock legend Tom Petty played this Truetone guitar when he was at Sun Studios in Memphis. The shirt on display was worn on stage by Tom's bassist, Ron Blair.





Rammstein

Frontman Till Lindeman of German industrial metal pioneers Rammstein wore this reflective suit on stage while performing at Rosenball charity event in Vienna in 2002. The ESP guitar was used by Richard Kruspe throughout the 'Ahoi' and 'Liebe ist für alle da' tours from 2006 until 2011.

Sir Elton John wore this whimsical suit when he appeared on Disney's 'Totally Minnie' television program on 25th March 1988.



Pat Benatar

This classic B.C Rich Bich guitar was signed by longtime Pat Benatar guitarist Neil Giraldo. With massive hits like "You Better Run", "Heartbreaker", and "Love is a Battlefield", Pat Benatar was one of the biggest stars of the 1980s. Neil also has the unique distinction of being the first guitarist ever shown on MTV.

[Hard Rock Cafe]


Nouveau rockabilly virtuoso Brian Setzer signed this vintage Gretsch New Yorker guitar.
